BC Youth Week is a provincial celebration of youth held annually during the first week of May. It is a week of fun, interaction, and celebration intended to build a strong connection between the young people and their communities; profiling issues, accomplishments and diversity of youth across the province.

BC Youth Week was created in 1995, when a handful of municipalities launched a new and exciting initiative designed to promote partnerships and celebrate youth in British Columbia. Over 20 years later, BC Youth Week has become an opportunity for people to learn about, and from, the youth of their community. From May 1st to 7th, youth in BC will embrace the spirit of BC Youth Week by participating in activities and events organized *by youth for youth*, while honoring and celebrating their diversity and their many contributions in their communities.

Youth Week events have included youth award ceremonies, advocacy campaigns, service projects, entertainment events and other events to showcase, educate and empower youth in our communities. 




